NAME OF PROGRAM/MAJOR: BACHELOR OF APPLIED SCIENCE AS-10

RATIONALE: Program has had low enrollment since its inception in 2004. Originally designed for those with an A. A. S. to get a B. A. S. but lack of opportunities in the business field (area of emphasis deleted at COB request in 2011) and technical areas due to lack of online courses and prerequisites meant that program never was popular. Currently there are no students or faculty in the program, staff are shared between the RBA and BAS, so no separate staff positions or budget was allocated for the program. Any students that resurface can seamlessly integrate into the RBA program.

CURRICULUM: 120 hours, 39 hours upper level with 42 general education hours chosen from existing courses and completion of an approved area of emphasis in social policy, administrative communications, digital forensics, web application development, or computer application development. No separate courses are required or offered for the BAS program.
