COLLEGE OF BUSINESS:

COURSE TITLE TO BE ADDED: Creativity & Innovation ENT 220 3 credit hours

DESCRIPTION: Introduction to creativity theory, including exposure to basic frameworks, concepts, and obstacles to creativity. Through practical application, the relationships between creativity, innovation and entrepreneurship are explored.

*Pre-requisite(s): None

COURSE TITLE TO BE ADDED: The Startup Experience ENT 350 3 credit hours

DESCRIPTION: An experiential learning course, students will complete a portion of this course as an apprentice at a new or small business followed by experience starting an online business.

*Pre-requisite(s): MGT 360

COURSE TITLE TO BE ADDED: Dilemmas & Debates in Entrp. ENT 370 3 credit hours

DESCRIPTION: Refereed by a faculty member, students will engage with entrepreneurs to discuss issues relevant to new ventures including partnerships, working with family, debt, ethical dilemmas, and customer issues.

COURSE TITLE TO BE ADDED: Social Entrepreneurship ENT 380 3 credit hours

DESCRIPTION: Introduces students to social entrepreneurship, social venture models, and funding options including philanthropy, government funding, and income generating, self-sustaining business models.
