1. Name of Major: BBA in Risk Management & Insurance. Major Code = BM40; CIP Code = 24521701

Rationale:

The COB, and the Division of Finance & Economics (within which this program is housed), request deletion of the Degree Program and its associated major. Summary of six key reasons below:

- 1. No faculty on staff who are trained or certified in the field of RMI
- 2. University provides no funding for this program
- 3. The RMI Industry Donor Group has not been successful at raising funds
- 4. All other fund-raising efforts have been unsuccessful
- 5. Enrollments have plummeted
- 6. Because this program has no faculty and no resources, it does not meet any of the college's accreditation standards.
