Story:

A pharmacist, Sempronio, is very interested in marrying his rich ward, Grilletta, thus securing her money for himself. Grilletta, however, loves Mengone, who, disguised as an apprentice, lives in Sempronio's house to be near her.

Grilletta has a third suitor, Volpino, an elegant gentleman, who tries to bribe Sempronio to give up his ward by promising him the position of Court Pharmacist to the Sultan of Turkey. Sempronio seems to agree to this proposal but sends Mengone to fetch a notary to draw up a wedding contract for himself. Instead of the notary, both Volpino and Mengone appear disguised as notaries. Each draws up a settlement and each signs his own name in place of Sempronio's. The fraud is quickly discovered.

Now Volpino's friends, disguised as Turks, arrive and cart away Sempronio's whole pharmacy. At this, Volpino is unmasked and discredited, and Sempronio consents to Grilletta's marriage to Mengone.
