### COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS:

- MI 423 Echocardiography I 4 hours  
This course is a continuation of MI 423
- MI 425 Echocardiography II 3 hours  
This course is a continuation of MI 425
- MI 426 Advanced Clinical Practice II 4 hours  
\*Students will arrange clinical experience in selected imaging modality to gain competency in clinical procedures required to sit for post-primary ARRT certification exams

### COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS:

- ENG 214 Introductions to Comics 3 hours  
*\*Add Course and Catalog Description:*  
Introduction of the literary art form of comics through a study of its history, genres, conventions, and complexities. **PR:** Completion of Core II composition requirement. *\*Add Core II as Humanities designator*
- ENG 232 Good Films 3 hours  
*\*Add Course and Catalog Description:*  
Study of films as narratives, as cultural representation, and as aesthetic expressions. *\*Add Core II as Humanities designator*
- ENG 440 Advanced Study in Film 3 hours  
*\*Add Course and Catalog Description:*  
Intensive study of a specific theme or genre. Topics will vary. May be repeated up to 6 hours with permission of chair. **PR:** ENG 350 or permission of chair
- ENG 442 Gender and Sexuality in Film 3 hours  
*\*Add Course and Catalog Description:*  
Exploration of evolving portrayals of gender roles and sexualities throughout film history and across film genres. **PR:** ENG 350 or permission of chair

- HIST 488 British History in Film 3 hours  
**\*Add Course and Catalog Description:**  
 This course explores selected aspects of British history through the study of films and key texts.
  
- PSY 223L Elem Behavioral Stats Lab 1 hour  
**\*Add Course and Catalog Description:**  
 A laboratory course accompanying PSY 223, emphasizing experiential exercises related to methodology and research in psychology. **Co-requisite:** PSY 223; **Pre-requisite:** MTH 121 or higher
  
- PSY 323L Experimental Psychology Lab 1 hour  
**\*Add Course and Catalog Description:**  
 A laboratory course accompanying PSY 323, emphasizing experiential exercises related to methodology and research in psychology. **Co-requisite:** PSY 323; **Pre-requisite:** PSY 201, PSY 223
  
- PSY 490 Intro to Teaching in Psych 3 hours  
**\*Add Course and Catalog Description:**  
 This course is designed to provide students with an introductory experience to teaching in psychology. **Pre-requisite:** Permission of instructor
