• COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS:

NUR 333L Physical Assessment Lab 1 hour Rationale: Combining this class with NUR 333 as text and content are the same. The grade students receive in this class is based upon their work in NUR 333 and is the grade from NUR 333 as long as they are satisfactory in NUR 333L. Although there are some clinically oriented requirements, students can complete these on family and/or friends and do not have to be in the clinical area.

NUR 427L Prof Engage Pract NUR
Rationale: COHP wants to combine the content and assignments for NUR 427
and 427L and delete NUR 427L. These two courses were separated several years ago when the classes for first developed. At that time, Administration was encouraging courses within Nursing be slot into lab and lecture session to help track faculty workload. Also, when this class was developed, students were required to spend a specific number of hours in the clinical setting for the clinical portion of the class. This is no longer the case as there are not set of number of clinical hours for NUR 427L. In lieu of clinical hours, students now complete specific clinical projects.
