Recommends approval of the listed LC40 We are revising the program to consist of fewer hours (from 39 to 36), fewer required hours (from 21 to 12 hours), more elective hours (from 18 to 24), and no emphasis areas (see Emphasis Area forms). We are eliminating CJ211, CJ231, CJ322, CJ325, and a statistics course as required courses, and making 2 existing courses (CJ302: Research Methods and CJ492: Senior Seminar) required courses. This will streamline our program, make it more flexible to meet student needs, make it less confusing for the students and advisors, and facilitate assessment. CURRICULUM: (If addition or change, number of hours and courses; indicate if required or optional) May be submitted as separate document Curriculum will consist of 4 required courses for 12 hours (CJ200: Intro. to Criminal Justice, CJ302: Research Methods, CJ404: Theoretical Criminology, CJ492: Senior Seminar) and 8 additional courses for 24 hours (students will select from all available electives or choose from lists of suggested electives depending on their interest in either Law Enforcement, Legal Studies, or Corrections.
