#### **ACADEMIC AFFAIRS**

FYS 100 First Year Seminar 3 hours  
Students will learn critical thinking skills integral to life-long learning through discussion, interaction, discovery, problem-solving, writing, research, reflection, and examination of multicultural/international issues. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: None

#### **COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & HUMAN SERVICES**

ESS 443 Principles of Strength and Conditioning Lab 1 hour  
Laboratory course that demonstrates strength and conditioning skills. Practical application of strength and conditioning principles with emphasis on the teaching of flexibility, powerlifting, Olympic weightlifting, and speed and agility programs. Co-requisites: ESS 442. Prerequisite(s): ESS 321, 345

FYS 100 H First Year Seminar-Honors 3 hours
