Recommends that the following academic program be continued with corrective action required:

BA – Communication Studies

**RATIONALE:**

Academic Planning Committee reviewers evaluated this academic program report and submitted their recommendation. According to the reviewers, the major weakness of this program review appeared to be the assessment component. The department has a new chair who inherited a program that had not conducted an assessment for four years. The new chair plans to correct this situation, but the reviewers felt it unrealistic to expect a fully developed assessment plan before this year's submission deadline. Therefore continuation with corrective action was recommended to the Academic Planning Committee. The Academic Planning Committee voted on and passed a recommendation of corrective action to include the program resubmitting an assessment plan by November 1, 2010.
