Recommends approval of the listed **COURSE ADDITIONS** in the following colleges and/or schools:

- **COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & HUMAN SERVICES**

ECE 485-488 Independent Study in Early Childhood Education 1-4 hours
Permission of the coordinator. Requires 2.5 GPA, limit of 6 hours to be used in professional education as a specialization. Co-requisite(s): N/A. Prerequisite(s): N/A.

ESS 301 Philosophy of Sport & Physical Activity 3 hours
Development of philosophic reasoning skills to better understand the role that philosophy plays in our understanding and conception of physical activity. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): ESS 118 or 218.

HS 200 Medical Terminology for the Athletic Trainers 3 hours
This course is designed to introduce students to basic medical terminology and basic pharmacology. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): None.

HS 212 Taping and Wrapping Techniques in Athletic Training 3 hours
This course is designed to introduce students to current taping and wrapping techniques commonly used in athletics. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): None.

- **COLLEGE OF FINE ARTS**

THE 111 Introduction to Acting 3 hours
Explore acting technique through theatre games, exercises, and improvisation. Good vocal skills and effective movement are emphasized. For non majors with little or no training in the acting discipline. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): None.

THE 201 Critical Analysis of Theatre Literature 3 hours
Critical analyses of theatre texts with emphasis on the successful translation of theatre literature from page to stage. Coursework supports the development and communication of production ideas and aesthetic interpretation. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): THE 101.

- **COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS**

LAT 250 Conversational Latin 3 hours
Introduction to basic skills or oral comprehension, composition, and pronunciation of Latin. Co-requisite(s): None. Prerequisite(s): LAT 204.
