	ANT 333 Linguistic Anthropology 3 hours Rationale: The Department has no linguist on staff to teach this class. To continue to offer a four-field Anthropology program (encompassing: linguistic, socio-cultural & biological/physical anthropology and archaeology), we have talked with the Department of English, which has agreed to cross-list two existing linguistics classes with Anthropology. This way, we secure our students the very best teaching by specialists in the field and use our limited resources most efficiently. The classes to cross-list are ENG 478 Introduction to Sociolinguistics (as a required class) and ENG 475 Introduction to Linguistics (as an elective).
