Recommends approval of the listed MAJORS, MINORS, CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS, AREAS OF EMPHASIS—ADDITIONS/DELETIONS/CHANGES from the following colleges and/or schools:

COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & HUMAN SERVICES

Action Requested: Deletion of an existing area of emphasis in Preschool Education Rationale: The program is no longer housed in FCS (Family & Consumer Sciences) but in the SOE (School of Education) where the faculty resides which is in Early Childhood Education.

COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS

Action Requested: Addition of a major in French

<u>Rationale</u>: Corrective actions requested by Academic Affairs as the areas of emphasis of Spanish, French and German each have a distinct curriculum and share no coursework.

<u>Curriculum</u>: 30 semester hours with 21 hours in courses numbered above 204 and must include 9 hours of courses at the 400 level; one 3-hour course of French culture or literature in translation will be allowed to count towards the completion of the required hours for the major. FRN 101, 102, 112, 203, 204, 305/306, 315/316, 323/324, 240, 335/336, 304, 317/318, 401, 402, 403, 404.

Action Requested: Addition of a major in German

<u>Rationale</u>: Corrective actions requested by Academic Affairs as the areas of emphasis of Spanish, French and German each have a distinct curriculum and share no coursework.

<u>Curriculum</u>: 33 semester hours with 21 hours in courses numbered above 204 and must include 9 hours of courses at the 400 level; two 3-hour courses of German culture or literature in translation will be allowed to count towards the completion of the required hours for the major. Action Requested: Addition of a major in Spanish
