- **COLLEGE OF EDUCATION & HUMAN SERVICES**

CISP 422 Differentiated Instruction 3 hours
Research-based strategies for providing differentiated instruction to students with diverse learning, social, and behavioral needs who are being educated in inclusive settings. Co-requisite(s)/Prerequisite(s): PR: CISP 421

- **COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS**

ENG 426 Appalachian Lit & Theory 3 hours
Appalachian Literature and Theory conducts an in-depth study of aspects of Appalachian culture and literature through the lens of select literary and social theories such as multiculturalism, feminism, or post-colonialism. Co-requisite(s)/Prerequisite(s): Any 300 level English but 302.

HST 313 Intro to Modern Africa 3 hours
This course chronicles the "modern" history of sub-Saharan Africa from late 19th century to today. Co-requisite(s)/Prerequisite(s): None.
