**UNIVERSITY FUNCTIONS COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-06-07-17 UFC

Recommends that the honor of serving as Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal would be rotated and staggered among the colleges. Both a Chief Marshal and an Assistant Chief Marshal will be elected in the first year and a new Assistant Chief Marshal would be chosen every two years thereafter. The Assistant Chief Marshal would rotate into the position of Chief Marshal every two years. The professors who are given the honor of serving as Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal would be elected by the faculty of the respective college.

RATIONALE:

Due to the retirement of Dr. David Woodward in 2006 as Chief Marshal, there needs to be a selection of someone to be Chief Marshal. It is also recommended that an Assistant Chief Marshal be chosen, so that the Assistant Chief Marshal could serve in the event the Chief Marshal is unable to fulfill their obligations. The honor of Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal would not reside in the same college and the size of the college would not be a determining factor in choosing the Marshal, so that each college would be equally honored. Since the Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal require special training, the Chief Marshal and Assistant Chief Marshal would be chosen every two years.
