Recommends approval of the listed **COURSE DELETIONS** in the following colleges and/or schools:

COLLEGE OF HEALTH PROFESSIONS

DTS 304 Fundamentals of Meal Planning

Rationale: Many concepts addressed in course are no longer relevant to Dietetics practice. Relevant content will be absorbed in other major courses. The course is only offered for pre-dietetics and dietetics majors; therefore, other departments/divisions will not be notified.

Course being added in place of this deletion: DTS 215: Assessment and Education Strategies in DTS.

DTS 478 Senior Practicum in DTS

Rationale: DTS 476 (Senior Seminar) and 478 do not have adequate content to be taught separately. Therefore, important concepts from 478 will be absorbed into DTS 476. The course is only offered for senior dietetics majors, therefore, other departments/divisions will not be notified. Course being added in place of this deletion: Principles of Management (320) will be required for

majors in place of DTS 478.

COLLEGE OF SCIENCE

CHM 362 Intermediate Organic Chemistry Lab

<u>Rationale</u>: This is a low enrollment course that is no longer required for any of our majors. This course is exclusive taken by Chemistry majors.

Course being added in place of this deletion: None.

MTH 422 Applied Time Series Analysis

<u>Rationale</u>: MTH 422 and MTH 522 are being replaced by MTH 663. A separate course change is being submitted concurrently to renumber MTH 522 to MTH 663. The course content makes this course more appropriate to graduate students.

Course being added in place of this deletion: MTH 663.
