CURRICULUM COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SR-05-06-(26) 71-128 CC

Recommends approval of the listed **COURSE ADDITIONS** in the following colleges and/or schools:

◆ **COLLEGE OF LIBERAL ARTS**

SPN 407 Foreign Language Teaching Methodology 3 hours
Analysis and practical application of methods of teaching foreign language, including professional development, language pedagogy, and language standards. To be taken concurrently with CI 470. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: Permission.

SPN 433 Intensive Advanced Spanish Grammar 3 hours
This course will review and expand specific, advanced Spanish language structural points. It will include daily intensive practice in the four linguistic skills. Course taught in Spanish. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: SPN 315/316 or SPN 323/324 or Permission.

SPN 444 Bilingual Contrastive Grammar 3 hours
This course will compare Spanish and English grammatical structures. It will be taught in both languages to demonstrate the similarities, differences, and intertwining relationship between them. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: SPN 315/316 or SPN 323/324 or Permission.

SPN 435 Contemporary Latin American Culture 3 hours
Course based on the origins of issues confronting contemporary Spain: the war and its aftermath, the transition to democracy and modernization, the European Union, terrorism, regional autonomy, feminism, and sexual identity. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: SPN 315/326 or SPN 323/324.

SPN 436 Culture and Society in Contemporary Spain 3 hours
Course based on origins of issues confronting contemporary Spain: the war's aftermath, transition to democracy and modernization, the European Union, terrorism, regional autonomy, feminism, sexual identity. Course taught in Spanish. Co-requisite/Prerequisite: SPN 315/316 or SPN 323/324

◆ **COLLEGE OF SCIENCE**

IST 463 Digital Evidence and Computer Investigation 3 hours
Concepts of computer forensics, including handling digital evidence, case preparation, forensic imaging, data recovery, password cracking, e-mail analysis, and report writing. Proper use of different forensic tools is emphasized. Prerequisite: IST 264
