# CURRICULUM COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

### SR-04-05-(43) 100 CC

Recommends that Article VI, Section 9B of <u>The Constitution of the Marshall University Faculty</u> be amended to require that a college's representative to the University Curriculum Committee be selected from the college's curriculum committee with the Section to read as follows: (new language is shown in bold font).

Section 9. Curriculum Committee

B. Membership. Committee membership shall include one representative from the college curriculum committee of each academic unit having undergraduate programs, one representative from the Marshall University Libraries, and one senator representing an academic unit having undergraduate programs appointed by the Executive Committee. One undergraduate student shall be appointed by the Student Government Association. Ex-officio, nonvoting members shall be the Provost and the Dean of each undergraduate college or school.

## **RATIONALE:**

This recommendation is being made at the request of the University Curriculum Committee. It is felt that the change will provide better coordination and communication between the University Curriculum Committee and the various academic units.
