PHYSICAL FACILITIES & PLANNING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SR-03-04-51 PFPC

Recommends that new maps be generated to depict Marshall University's central campus and outlying buildings, and that these maps be updated as new buildings and facilities are added.

RATIONALE:

Marshall University's current campus map includes only the central campus's buildings and grounds. This committee suggests creating new maps to include outlying facilities that are not on the main campus. Possibilities include the Marshall University Medical Center, Marshall University School of Medicine, forensic science facility, ceramics building, University Housing, Marshall University Graduate College, psychology clinic, as well as sites in Teays Valley and Point Pleasant. The committee contends that the graphics department should have creative control as to how the maps are developed, but that there is a definite need to create new maps and update them as the need arises.


