**INDIVIDUAL SENATOR
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-03-04-56 IS

Recommends approval to change the name of the College of Nursing and Health Professions to College of Health Professions.

RATIONALE:

On August 21, 2003, the faculty of the College of Nursing and Health Professions voted unanimously to change the name of their college to "College of Health Professions." CONHP faculty consider the current name to be cumbersome, routinely shortened in speech to "College of Nursing." As a result, faculty and students in the other health professions (Communication Disorders, Dietetics, and Clinical Lab Sciences) are inappropriately identified with the nursing profession. The college faculty believe that the new name better describes the nature of the college and represents all its programs equally. The college dean, the university Provost, President, and Vice President for Health Science have all approved this change.
