**BUDGET & ACADEMIC POLICY COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-02-03-(9) 39 BAPC

Recommends a revision to the late registration policy as proposed by the Deans Council. The revised policy would read as follows: "Beginning in Fall 2003, late registration for on-campus, undergraduate students will be limited to the first three days of each regular semester. Schedule adjustment for enrolled students will continue to be held during the first week of each regular semester."

RATIONALE:


The Associate Deans and Deans would like to limit the number of students registering for classes for the first time during the first week of classes. These students are joining all of their classes after the classes have begun. Each of these students therefore starts every class at a disadvantage, having missed valuable class time. This undermines student retention and student success.
