FACULTY SENATE RECOMMENDATION

SR-01-02-13 (FS)

Recommends to the President that he marshal all the available resources—faculty, staff, and students—to express to the Legislature our deep concern over potential budget cuts.

RATIONALE:

- 1 The Higher Education Policy Commission's budget request compared to the Governor's recommendation shows:
 - A The University's FY 2003 budget request is \$62,076,150. The Governor has recommended \$60,489,816.
 - B The Governor's budget moves \$200,000 for MU Rural Health Center to general revenue funding.
 - C SB 653 Funding for Peer Equity/Sustained Quality Support is \$3 million less than the FY 2003 budget request.
 - D The malpractice insurance premium and the PEIA premium to be paid by the university are expected to be \$750,000 more than last year.
- 2 The Governor and Legislature are best served by having input from faculty, staff, and students on matters such as these.
