LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SR-00-01-(6) 47 (LA)

Recommends that the Faculty Senate support a legislation that permits faculty with 12-month appointment to donate their un-used sick leave time to other faculty and staff who need it. The Committee further urges the University President and each faculty member to encourage state legislators to support this recommendation.

RATIONALE:

- Current legislation does not permit faculty with 12-month appointment to do so-due to the wording errors used in the legislation--as indicated by our ACF representative, Dr. Ben Miller, in his report to the Faculty Senate on September 30, 1999.
- 2. Such a bill was not introduced in the West Virginia State Legislature in 2000.
