**LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION**

SR-00-01-(7) 48 (LA)

Recommends that the Faculty Senate support the concept of, and any bill to be introduced, which would legalize state employees' service in the West Virginia Legislature. The Committee further urges the University President and each faculty member to encourage state legislators to support this recommendation.

RATIONALE:

1. It is plainly, un-American, that a group of citizens not be allowed to so serve.
2. There is precedent that Public School teachers though not technically state employees (but who receive the majority of their salaries from state taxes) are allowed to serve.
