SR-00-01-(21) 62 (CC)

Recommends approval of the listed **COURSE CHANGE** for the **College of Information Technology & Engineering**:

1. SED 490 Safety Internship
Change in credit hours FROM: 3 hours TO: 3-12 hours.
Rationale: Most students take 3 hours and complete 150+ hours of work. A need has arisen where a student may take a job, which lasts for a semester, and a student will work 40 hours a week for 12 to 16 weeks. This change will help students on the GI Bill receive monies due them based on clock hours rather than semester hours.
