SR-99-00-3 (BAPC)

High Demand Courses in Mathematics

The classification of certain mathematics courses as "High Demand" would eliminate the excessive dropping of these courses during the withdrawal period. This committee recommends the approval of the following list of mathematics courses as "High Demand": MTH 121, MTH 123, MTH 127, MTH 130, and MTH 203.

RATIONALE:

1. Large numbers of students register for these courses, but they do not complete them.
2. It causes registration problems for other students, who are unable to register for courses.
3. High Demand courses can serve to remind students to remain in courses until completion.
