RATIONALE: Introduction to Industrial-Organizational Psychology (I-O) has been offered successfully several times as a special topics course. The course is important to graduate students in our General/Theoretical program who are emphasizing Human Resource Development as their special interest. The course provides an overview of the field and provides a basis for more advanced coursework and internship experiences. It also exposes students to pertinent literature in the field which can form the basis of these projects.

Child and Family Therapy is being added because it covers important literature and clinical strategies for clinical psychologists. Virtually all clinicians work with children and families, and must be familiar with this area.
