

### ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND CURRICULA REVIEW COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

# SR-93-94-57(ASCR)

That the Academic Forgiveness Policy, as stated in the current 1993-95 Undergraduate Catalog, page 47, paragraph 3, be amended and be stated as follows:

"In order to receive a degree or certificate, the student must complete at least 24 additional credit hours through actual coursework from Marshall university after the non-enrollment period, earn at least a 2.0 GPA <u>overall</u> on all work attempted after the non-enrollment period and satisfy all degree or certificate requirements. Grades disregarded for GPA computation will remain on the student's permanent record. A student whose overall GPA falls below 2.0 after the forgiveness period will forfeit Academic Forgiveness and may be dealt with on an individual basis by his/her dean."

NOTE: Only the underlined words above were added. No words or phrases were deleted.

**RATIONALE:** The word "overall" was added after "2.0 GPA" so as not to mean a 2.0 grade or better in each single course attempted. The sentence added at the end of the paragraph is added for clarification of the overall policy on academic forgiveness.
