STUDENT CONDUCT AND WELFARE COMMITTEE
RECOMMENDATION

SR-93-94-59(SCW)

The practice of tuition waivers for the Student Government Association President and Vice-President shall be continued.

RATIONALE: Experience gained from student leadership positions and service given to the university warrant the award of tuition waivers. SCW committee considers the elimination of these waivers arbitrary. The time required to adequately carry out the duties of these SGA positions limits the possibilities for part-time employment.
