SR-93-94-87(GR)

To approve the proposal from the College of Education to change the Education Specialist (Ed.S.) certificate to an Ed.S. degree.

RATIONALE: The academic requirements and rigor of the Ed.S. certificate program at Marshall University are equivalent to those for the Ed.S. degree at many leading institutions throughout the country. Having an Ed.S. degree rather than a certificate will enable Marshall University students who have completed this program to be competitive with students who received the Ed.S. degree from other institutions.
