To approve the following **COURSE ADDITIONS**:

- ELT 111: Direct Current Circuit Analysis - 3 hours credit
- ELT 121: Alternating Current Circuit Analysis - 3 hours credit
- ELT 131: Analog Circuits I - 3 hours credit
- ELT 141: Analog Circuits II - 3 hours credit
- ELT 211: Combinational Logic Circuits - 3 hours credit
- ELT 221: Sequential Logic Circuits - 3 hours credit
- ELT 231: Electronic Communication Circuits - 3 hours credit
- ELT 241: Electronic Communication Systems - 3 hours credit

RATIONALE: These are not additions of new courses. Courses have been taught for 10 years in an articulation agreement with Cabell County Vo-Tech with the electronic component being taught at the Center and with the support courses taught at the Community and Technical College.


