SR-92-93-(6) 152 (ASCR)

That the name and alpha designator of the department of Computer and Information Sciences (CIS) be renamed as the department of Computer Science and Software Development (CSD).

RATIONALE: The new name more accurately reflects the emphasis of the department on modern software engineering approaches, so urgently needed in this region--and thus important to the student graduating in the future, as well as our continuing emphasis on strong foundational material in computer science.
