Whereas, on March 21, 1991, the Faculty Senate of Marshall University unanimously endorsed the inclusion of the "sexual orientation" in Board of Trustees' Policy Bulletin #56, and

Whereas, the University Senate of West Virginia University has endorsed the inclusion of the category "sexual orientation" in Policy Bulletin #56, and

Whereas, West Virginia's two universities include the category of "sexual orientation" in their affirmative action statements, and

Whereas, the Board of Directors has voted to include the category of sexual orientation in its protected groups, and

Whereas, the Advisory Council of Faculty to the University of West Virginia System has endorsed the inclusion of "sexual orientation" in Policy Bulletin #56, and

Whereas, higher education has a special obligation to lead in the development of a more just, tolerant and humane society that acknowledges and supports human diversity, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Marshall University Faculty Senate calls upon the Board of Trustees to reconsider its position and to vote to restore the category "sexual orientation" to the list of groups protected under Policy Bulletin #56.
