AD HOC CALENDAR COMMITTEE
Recommendation

SR-91-92-53 (AHC)

That the time of spring break be established as the last full week in March.

DISCUSSION:

1. A study of academic calendars for the last ten years reveals that the time of spring break is not fixed and has been scheduled as early as March 2 and as late as March 27. No other break is so random. Establishing a definite time for spring break allows students and teachers alike to plan their schedules.
2. Assigning the last full week in March for spring break more closely balances the two semesters. A break later in the semester can ensure better travel conditions for students and provides a better break in general.
