Recommendation

SR-91-92-71(LA)

That funding be requested from the legislature to raise university stipends for full-time graduate assistantships to a minimum of \$4,000 plus tuition waivers without reducing the number of stipends offered.

DISCUSSION AND RATIONALE:

1. Graduate assistantships at Marshall are lower than those at any other comparable SREB institution and at West Virginia University.
2. Because we are not competitive it is very difficult to recruit and retain qualified graduate students, which weakens our graduate programs.
