

STUDENT CONDUCT & WELFARE COMMITTEE Recommendation

SR-91-92-88(SCW)

To approve the following change to the Visitation Policy for students living in dormitories:

24-hour visitation for residents within the buildings that are co-education. Visitors who do not reside within those buildings will be subject to the general visitation policy.

RATIONALE: Currently, this change will affect only Holderby Hall, where students live co-educationally on floors 4-8. For a female to visit a male, or vice versa, the host and visitor must go downstairs and sign in the guest. This is a frustrating and time-consuming procedure. Residents of these floors feel that the proposed change in policy will enhance the community development and freedom within the building without compromising security. (Residence Life staff informs us that such arrangements have contributed to reduction of vandalism, a greater sense of security for female students and increased opportunities of young adults to develop platonic relationships with the opposite gender.)
