That the following "Policy on Thesis Binding" be approved:

POLICY ON THESIS BINDING

The graduate student shall submit three (3) unbound copies of his/her thesis to the Graduate School with a receipt for the binding fee for three (3) copies. Information on current binding fees is available through the Bursar's office. These copies are to be bound through the library, with two (2) copies to be kept by the library and one (1) to be sent to the student's department. It is the student's responsibility to bind personal copies. (This policy will be implemented starting in the First Summer Session, 1992.)

RATIONALE: The library can no longer underwrite the extra expense of binding student copies of theses. Less expensive means of binding student copies are available for binding student copies.
