SR-91-92-102(EC)

- WHEREAS:** Proposals are being considered to control the use of copying technology and the making of copies on the Marshall University campus, and
- WHEREAS:** The primary mission of Marshall University is education, and
- WHEREAS:** The Administration has repeatedly pledged to retain the "integrity of the classroom," and
- WHEREAS:** The classroom is a dynamic arena of thought and action and thus it is impossible to foresee every need for copying technology that would be useful in the classroom, and
- WHEREAS:** Research conducted by faculty members often may require unplanned uses of copying technology, and
- WHEREAS:** Faculty research contributes to the quality of classroom education,
- BE IT RESOLVED:** That academic and faculty research activities be exempted from any policy concerning the use of copying technology at Marshall University.
