AD HOC CALENDAR COMMITTEE Recommendation

SR-90-91-(5)158 (AHC)

That the 48-hour deadline for the submission of grades after a final has been given be a suggested deadline only.

RATIONALE:

- 1) An ad hoc committee survey shows that 49.7% of faculty do not submit grades within 48 hours because:
 - A) students have not taken the final (35.4%);
 B) students have not completed work (35.9%);
 C) departmental duties interfere (33.8%);
 D) committee work interferes (28%);

 - E) preparation of other exams interferes (43.4%);
 - F) grading of essay exams interferes (59.8%).
- 2) This again is a calendar policy that is governed by faculty. The original rule came from the University Council. Therefore, any changes to this policy must also come from faculty.
