SR-90-91-(27)180 (SGA)

To approve SGA's "dead week" of class exams immediately before final exams. (no exams to be scheduled during the last week of class during Fall and Spring semesters)

RATIONALE: Studying for final exams is a difficult task within itself and the scheduling of exams the week before finals complicates student's preparation for final exams. Allowing the week prior to finals to be free of exams would alleviate students of the pressure of studying for extra exams. Major papers assigned well beforehand would be exempt from this. This policy may allow students to perform better on final exams.
