Recommendation

SR-90-91-(55)208 (EC)

To rescind the Senate policy (passed January 28, 1988) requiring that the names of all Senators who have missed three meetings during the year be placed in the minutes.

RATIONALE: The policy is no longer needed:

- 1) The names of absent Senators are listed in the minutes of Senate meetings, so a separate statement re any Senator who has missed three meetings is unnecessary to inform the Senate and the rest of the faculty.
- 2) The Senate President sends a "warning" letter to any Senator who has missed three meetings so a public notification is not necessary to warn the individual of excessive absences.
