

SR-90-91-(55)208 (EC)

To <u>rescind</u> the Senate policy (passed January 28, 1988) requiring that the names of all Senators who have missed three meetings during the year be placed in the minutes.

RATIONALE: The policy is no longer needed:

1) The names of absent Senators are listed in the minutes of Senate meetings, so a separate statement re any Senator who has missed three meetings is unnecessary to inform the Senate and the rest of the faculty.

2) The Senate President sends a "warning" letter to any Senator who has missed three meetings so a public notification is not necessary to warn the individual of excessive absences.
