Recommendation

SR-90-91-(117)269 (ASCR)

Instructors must file a copy of their course syllabi with the chairperson during the first two weeks of fall and spring semester classes and during the first three days of summer term classes.

RATIONALE: Such a procedure would avoid problems arising as a result if faculty members are not available when their syllabi are needed--for example during grade appeals or accreditation visits.
