STUDENT CONDUCT AND WELFARE COMMITTEE

Recommendation

SR-89-90-115 (SCW)

That the administration of Marshall University should propose to the Student Conduct and Welfare and the Faculty Personnel Committees a policy and grievance procedures concerning possible sanctions against faculty members who involve themselves in altercations on campus; this proposal should be ready for our consideration at our first meeting in the fall semester 1990.

DISCUSSION/RATIONALE: It was discovered that there is no adequate procedure available to students except in cases of sexual harrassment. The Grievance Panel requested that the Student Conduct & Welfare Committee explore the possibility of instituting a policy.

It was suggested the the Student Conduct & Welfare and Faculty Personnel Committees could jointly form a subcommittee to study the problem. However, the Student Conduct & Welfare Committee ultimately felt strongly that this is not an issue for the faculty committees to address, and that it is incumbent upon the administration to determine policy and present a proposal to the appropriate faculty committees for consideration. Further, The Student Conduct & Welfare Committee felt that a deadline should be specified for such a proposal to reach us so that a policy can be set in place as soon as possible for the up-coming academic year.
