Resolution to Recommend Issues for the ACF Legislative Agenda

Whereas, the Advisory Council of Faculty is a legislatively mandated organization comprised of representatives from all schools of higher education;

Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate of Marshall University recommends that the ACF adopt the following issues for its 2016-17 Legislative Agenda:

- The Legislature should create a steady stream of revenue for Higher Education.
- The Legislature should preserve the autonomy of the boards of governors of colleges and universities to establish gun control policies.
- The Legislature should support the work of the Higher Education Policy Commission to advance higher education in the state through administering grants and coordinating programs and curricula in the higher education systems.
- The Legislature should pass legislation allowing faculty of higher education to run for public office to serve in the West Virginia Legislature.
