**Resolution to Reject HB 2446, Permitting the Possession of
Firearms on the Grounds of Higher Education Institutions
by all Persons with Valid Licenses**

Whereas, this bill will override the ability of colleges and universities to regulate the carrying of firearms on their campuses;

Whereas, Marshall University Chief of Police James Terry has indicated that passage of this bill will strongly reduce the ability of MUPD to provide security to Marshall faculty, staff and students;

Be it resolved, that the Faculty Senate of Marshall University urges defeat of HB 2446, which would permit possession of firearms on the grounds of higher education institutions by all persons with valid licenses.
