The first family of Coopers here were Abel Mary Cooper of Guyandotte. They were one of several persons who bought 2000 acres of land in 1821, on the <sup>Ridge between</sup> ~~Right Fork~~ of Twelve Pole, and the Right Fork of Big Sandy River. In 1825, they purchased Lot 2, adjoining the town of Guyandotte. In 1836, they <sup>sold</sup> ~~purchased~~ a part of the Public Square in Guyandotte, and disappeared from the records. They probably moved away, but it is not known where they went.

Deed Book Four, page 24, under date of 1825, shows that the heirs of Leonard Cooper, deceased of Mason County, W. Va. having made a contract with Richard McCallister of Kanawha County, in 1804, a large tract of land in Kanawha <sup>but now Cabell County,</sup> County, at one dollar per acre.
