Henry Morris lived about  
1 1/2 miles beyond (E) Hurricane  
on the old turnpike on  
right, going up. Joshua  
was Henry Morris's father.  
Children of Henry Morris:

up in Pennsylvania some  
place. I can't call his  
name. Others were

Henry, Tom, Mat, went  
to Arkansas, <sup>Little Rock</sup> when quite  
young. A sister (name  
forgotten) moved with them.

William Morris - lived at

Fred J. Morris, my  
father lived at Winfield

was Joshua Morris.  
She had a twin

Geo. W. Summers' father  
was Thos. Summers. He died in  
1870 & was buried on my father's  
farm at Winfield. Father lived  
east of Winfield, on road toward  
Charleston about  $\frac{1}{4}$  miles. I remember  
discovering date & burial of Thos. S. because I saw them
