PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

The By-Laws Committee recommends a few changes in Article VII, Section 1, which now reads: Sec. 1 Membership Meetings. There shall be at least 3 meetings of the membership each year. Time and place shall be determined by the Board of Directors.
