# GFWC West Virginia President's Message



The 110th GFWC West Virginia Convention is in the books! And, what a wonderful Convention it was. Past State President Jody Cunningham and the entire 2014-2016 INSPIRE administration did a wonderful job. I thought you might be interested in a few statistics from 2015.

GFWC West Virginia club members contributed an astounding \$48,068.73, with in-kind donations totally \$341,668.26. Add those up and you have over a half a million dollars. At report time 84 clubs reported 4,660 projects and volunteering an amazing 145,982.35 hours. This was all done with less than 3,000 members.

At the 2016 GFWC West Virginia Convention we chartered two new clubs: GFWC Gilmer County Woman's Club and GFWC Junioresettes of Man. Re-federated clubs are the GFWC Woman's Club of Nitro and the GFWC 25840 Junior Alumni. These clubs are a welcome addition to our GFWC West Virginia Federation.

This president's 2016-2018 logo GFWC West Virginia PROUD! was seemingly well received at the closing of the 2016 convention. We are Proud of GFWC West Virginia and our great state. For those of you who were not there this president's colors are blue and green with a touch of gold.

The 2016-2018 State President's Special Project is entitled FEED OUR FUTURE. 118,000 thousand West Virginia children are on free and reduced lunches. What do these children do on weekends and holidays? FEED OUR FUTURE promotes backpack programs, brown bag programs, after school cafes, food pantry contributions and monetary donations to entities that FEED OUR FUTURE. Each district has a team member and each club president received information in their packets Sunday morning at convention. Remember: One child hungry is one too many.

We are working on the Summer Conference workshops and programs. The deadline for Registration is July 8th. We are hoping to offer approximately 15 workshops. All 15 workshops won't be for everyone but that is this president's

"dream." We are also hoping on having one of the GFWC partners attending.

Districts have the opportunity for get-togethers on Friday night. Those are always fun.

On Saturday night we are going to do a West Virginia Proud auction and table decoration evening. Please send your table reservation to State Meetings Planner Georgianna Tillis as soon as possible. We will have judges this year instead of voting with money. Let's show our West Virginia Pride!

I am delighted to be serving as Editor of the GFWC West Virginia Clubwoman Magazine for the current administration. I will not be doing a column each magazine, the other three issues this club year will be comprised of the events and projects of your clubs. Put my name on your mailing list, so I know what your projects are and who to contact in case of questions.

Clubs are being encouraged to use e-mail in word form to send in their articles and also to transmit photos for the magazine. Ad copy can also be submitted electronically to Michele Clark, advertising/circulation chairman at [clarks515@suddenlink.net](mailto:clarks515@suddenlink.net) thus saving the possibility of mistakes in the ads.

I am asking that clubs sell advertising all year and not just at honor point deadlines. If this is done the advertising can be spread out in all issues of the magazine. Take your magazine with you and show to your prospective advertiser. Tell them that the magazine is mailed to nearly 3,000 women in the state and nation each quarter, increasing the visibility of their business.

District wide advertising is being encouraged. If you have a fair or festival within your county, ask the clubs in your district to advertise the event and promote tourism in your area. Honor your District officers with an ad from all the clubs –telling them that they are appreciated for their hard work. Also if you have corporate businesses in your communities,

see if they will purchase an ad. A lot of times all you need to do is ask for their support of the women's clubs and they will come through for you.

Just a note on the circulation changes, additions and deletions for your club. Be sure that when new members are taken into your club, that the treasurer pays dues for them and then the name can go onto the mailing list. If dues are only paid one time a year by December 1st, they will not be eligible to receive the magazine until their state and district dues are paid.
