#11 This African-American man nearing seventy is from an urban area in the southern half of West Virginia. Referred as someone who believed this individual would fit within the scope of the project, interviews with sexual minorities from West Virginia, this informant did not identify himself as gay, bisexual or transgendered. He spoke of his mother as a "fiercely independent person," a classification he now gives to himself. He depicts scenes of black urban neighborhood life before the time of desegregation.
